

Dress Code



DRESS CODE REFERENCE GUIDE

Countryside's uniform policy exists to clearly define the standard of attire for our school. The goal for each student and family is to meet or exceed the CCS standard. It is not about what any individual student or parent deems appropriate, fashionable, or trendy, but about ensuring each student meets or exceeds the established CCS standard. Final judgment is at the discretion of the CCS administration.

The CCS Standard is defined as:

- Traditional Style-apparel that looks like a traditional school uniform.
- Classic Fit-apparel with a relaxed, loose fit and conservative length.
- Neat Appearance-apparel that is clean and absent of tears, or holes.

UNIFORM GUIDELINES (GRADES PK4-12)

TOPS

- CCS embroidered polo shirt, or CCS hoodie (loose-fitting)
- Undergarments must not clash with uniform color

BOTTOMS

- Solid khaki or black shorts, skirts, or pants
- Shorts/skirts: no shorter than 2" above the knee
- Traditional/classic fit, loose-fitting, no holes, tears, rips, or fraying

OUTERWEAR

- Inside: CCS Jackets, sweaters, hoodies, or sweatshirts only (hoods down)
- Outside/PE: Non-CCS outerwear allowed

FOOTWEAR

- Sneakers or casual dress shoe
- No slippers, high heels, flip-flops, "crocs", slides, or "heelies"

ACCESSORIES

- Boys must wear belts with shirts tucked in
- No hats or beanies
- Accessories must also meet or exceed the CCS standard

PE UNIFORM (3RD-8TH GRADE, AND HS STUDENTS TAKING PE)

- PE shirt (blue or black)
- PE shorts (blue or black)
- Joggers



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SPECIAL DRESS CODE ALLOWANCE

PRIVILEGE DAY (THURSDAYS)

On Thursdays, students may wear CCS spirit shirts, PE uniform or modest denim (knee-length shorts, jeans, capris) with no rips/holes. Students in 5th-12th grade must be on “privilege status” to participate.

SPIRIT DAY (FRIDAYS)

ALL students may wear a CCS t-shirt and uniform bottoms or full-length jeans (no jean shorts, no rips/holes)

HONOR ROLL CHAPEL/AWARDS DRESS

Girls: Modest dresses or skirts below the knee, loose-fitting, 2" minimum strap width. No flip-flops or sneakers. pant suits allowed if modest.

Boys: Dress shirt, tie, dress pants/khakis, belt and dress shoes

HAIR GUIDELINES

Girls: Neat, clean, out of eyes, styled to reflect femininity, natural color only

Boys: Neat clean, off shoulders and face, above mid-ear. no ponytails, man buns or accessories

-Grades 9-12 may have facial hair if neat and trimmed (subject to approval/privilege can be revoked)

PIERCINGS AND TATTOOS

Jewelry must be modest

NO earrings for boys

NO nose piercing's at school/events

NO visible tattoos. No new tattoos allowed after enrollment
